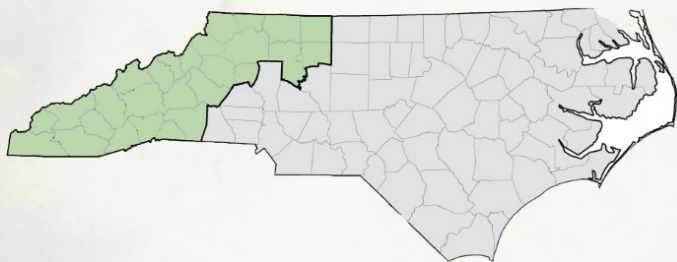




# College Access Partnerships 2011-2016

The College Access Partnerships at Appalachian State University support area students, teachers, and school districts in promoting access to higher education. The goal is to extend postsecondary access and success services throughout the Appalachian region of North Carolina. Working with area high schools, the program helps students explore possibilities for careers and then matches their aspirations to degree or certificate programs at area community colleges or a four year university.
